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WHY DEEP BEAST EXISTS

"Every generation inherits a world shaped by the education of the previous one."

This realization became the beginning of DEEP BEAST. Not because we believed education was failing, not because we wished to replace schools or teachers. But because we believed that meaningful learning requires an ecosystem larger than any single classroom. Teachers inspire, parents shape nurture, schools provide direction, communities shape character. Technology creates opportunities, society influences choices. When these forces work together, education becomes transformative. When they remain disconnected, learning becomes fragmented.

DEEP BEAST was founded on a simple belief:

improve it and leave it better than they found it.

We do not measure success by the number of books we publish, the technologies we create, or the products we sell. We measure success by a far more important question: “**Did we help someone learn something that changed their life?**” Every decision we make begins there. THE REALITY OF EDUCATION

Every meaningful solution begins with understanding the problem it seeks to solve. At DEEP BEAST, we believe educational innovation must be guided by evidence rather than assumptions. Before defining our purpose, we asked a simple question:

Where does Indian education stand today?

The answer is both inspiring and challenging.

1. India has transformed access to education

For much of the twentieth century, one of India's greatest educational challenges was ensuring that every child had access to school.

Today, that reality has changed dramatically.

Government initiatives such as the **Right to Education Act**, **Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan**, and **Samagra Shiksha** have contributed to near-universal enrolment at the elementary level. According to UDISE+ and the Economic Survey 2024–25, India's school education system now serves approximately **24.8 crore students** through **14.72 lakh schools**, supported by nearly **98 lakh teachers**, making it one of the largest education systems in the world.

Independent assessments such as the **Annual Status of Education Report (ASER)** have consistently shown that school enrolment among children aged 6–14 in rural India has remained above 95% for many years.

This represents one of India's greatest developmental achievements. The national conversation has therefore evolved. The question is no longer, "*Can every child reach school?*". The question has become:

What does every child learn after reaching school?

Access does not always guarantee learning:

Expanding access to education was the first milestone. Ensuring meaningful learning is the next. National learning assessments continue to show that many students struggle to achieve expected levels of Foundational Literacy and Numeracy (FLN) despite being enrolled in school.

The **ASER 2024** report found that many children are still unable to read grade-level text or perform age-appropriate arithmetic. These findings do not diminish the achievement of expanded enrolment; rather, they highlight a new national priority: improving learning outcomes.

School attendance and educational achievement are therefore related, but not identical. Education cannot be measured solely by years spent inside classrooms. Its true value lies in what learners understand, retain, and apply beyond them.

India has already recognized this challenge:

This concern is not unique to DEEP BEAST. It has already been acknowledged at the highest levels of educational policy.

The **National Education Policy (NEP) 2020** calls for a shift away from rote memorization toward:

- conceptual understanding;
- competency-based education;
- critical thinking;
- creativity;
- experiential learning;
- multidisciplinary problem-solving; and
- continuous learning.

Similarly, organizations such as **UNESCO** emphasize that quality education should equip learners not only with knowledge, but also with the skills, values, and competencies needed to participate meaningfully in society.

These recommendations reflect a shared understanding:

Education must prepare learners not only for examinations, but also for life.

A changing world requires a changing approach:

Children entering school today will graduate into a world fundamentally different from that of previous generations. Artificial intelligence is transforming industries. Digital technologies influence how children learn, communicate, and interact. Information has become abundant. The ability to evaluate, interpret, create, and apply that information has become increasingly valuable.

In such an environment, success depends not only on what learners know, but on how they think.

Curiosity, Adaptability, Ethical judgment, Creativity, Communication, Collaboration.

These are no longer optional qualities. They are essential competencies for the twenty-first century.

The opportunity before us

India has already demonstrated that large-scale educational transformation is possible.

The challenge before the nation is no longer expanding access alone. It is improving the quality, relevance, and lifelong impact of learning.

This challenge cannot be addressed by schools alone. Teachers, parents, educational institutions, communities, publishers, researchers, technologists, policymakers and responsible innovators all have a role to play.

DEEP BEAST chooses to become one of those contributors. Not because we believe the existing education system has failed. But because we believe it deserves every possible support to help every learner realize his or her full potential.

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WHAT WE BELIEVE

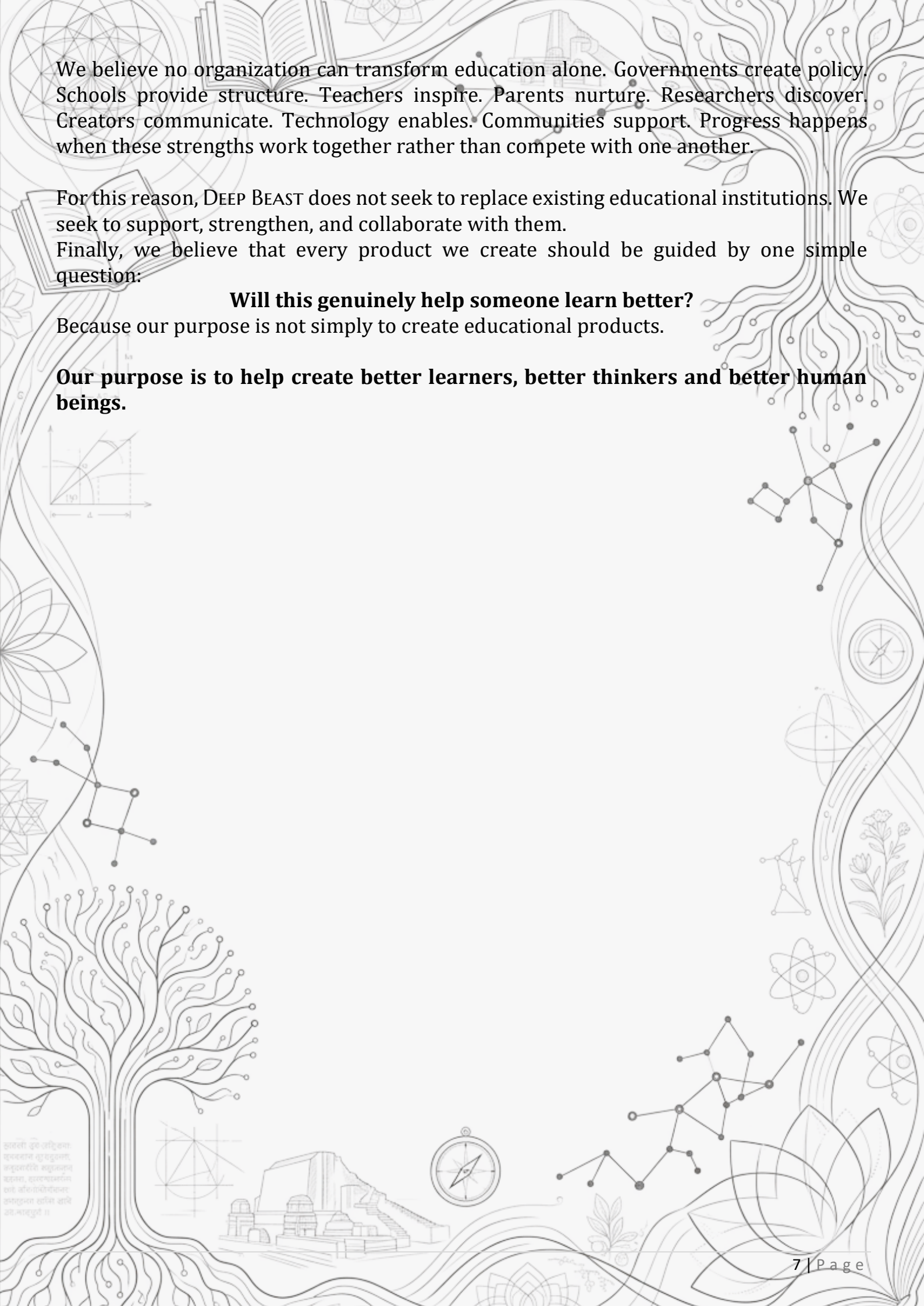
